CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION


Pastor: We are your baptized children, O God, fed by your Word and led by your Spirit, but we are also sinners.

1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy,



Please include in your prayers, Ethan, who was hit by a car at the Premium Outlets. Below is a note from his mom. Ethan attended Peace Preschool when he was younger and his sister is coming back here in the Fall. "It has been a pretty rough few days; (Ethan is still heavily sedated and unresponsive. Monday, he had his braces removed as they were shredding up his lips and interfering with MRI imaging. After his braces were removed, doctors had a repeat mri with contrast. Unfortunately, it did show some severe damage due to lack of oxygen. The doctors said his brain looks like it suffered some from trauma (physical) plus hypoxic from lack of oxygen. It was a pretty devastating report, but we're hanging onto a miracle for Mr. Ethan who is only 14 and has his entire life ahead of him. Today he was transferred to a hospital in LA. We're hoping that a new set of eyes and expertise will set us on the road to recovery. We appreciate all of the love, prayers, meals, and donations. This has been the worst 12 days of our lives! Thank you for helping us get through it. Please continue some serious prayers as everything is still so scary and uncertain. For anyone who knows Ethan knows what a lover he is, funny as heck, and so so cool! If anyone deserves a miracle, it's him?"
