

People: We confess that we have allowed the sorrows of this world to overshadow the certain faith the Holy Spirit has given us, at times diminishing or even forgetting the gracious promises You have made for the sake of Christ. Forgive us, heavenly Father.

Pastor: Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me." John 10:27

People: We confess that too often we have been wandering sheep, listening to each other's bleating and the allures of our fallen world, instead of paying attention to our Shepherd's voice. Forgive us, heavenly Father.




EASTER ACCLAMATION

People: Glory to You, O Lord!






