June 18, 2023

**As We Gather** Teaching. Healing. Proclaiming the Good News. Like a compassionate Shepherd longing to gather His scattered sheep, Jesus came to reconcile people to His Father. When Jesus sent His disciples as laborers into His harvest field, He guaranteed that His reconciling work would continue even after He physically departed the earth. Wherever Jesus’ Word is proclaimed and His sacraments are administered, He continues to gather souls into His kingdom. He does that for us in worship today! Having gathered us in His name, taught us with His Word, and healed us by His Supper, He will then send us out into His harvest field. Wherever we go, Jesus will continue His work, and His kingdom will be made known.

**Attention Visitors** We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God’s forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ’s body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God’s forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.
