THE DAY OF PENTECOST

June 5, 2022

As We Gather The Scriptures share many accounts of God coming down to earth. From the moment of creation when "the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters" (*Genesis 1:2*), God has come down to this favored planet many times and in many ways. On Pentecost, God the Holy Spirit came down to earth in a most dramatic way, fulfilling the promise of His descent that Jesus had made to His disciples. That blessed Spirit continues to come among God's people, calling, gathering, enlightening, and sanctifying them. As we gather, we witness to that Spirit at work among and through us.

Attention Visitors We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ's body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God's forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.

PSALM 139:1-12, 17

How vast is the sum of them!

People: O LORD, You have searched me and known me!

You know when I sit down and when I rise up;

You discern my thoughts from afar.

Pastor: You search out my path and my lying down

and are acquainted with all my ways.

People: Even before a word is on my tongue,

behold, O LORD, You know it altogether.

Pastor: You hem me in, behind and before,

and lay Your hand upon me.

People: Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;

it is high; I cannot attain it.

Pastor: Where shall I go from Your Spirit?

Or where shall I flee from Your presence?

People: If I ascend to heaven, You are there!

If I make my bed in depths, You are there!

Pastor: If I take the wings of the morning

and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

even there Your hand shall lead me, and Your right hand shall hold me.

People: If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me,

and the light about me be night,"

even the darkness is not dark to You;

the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with You.

All: How precious to me are Your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

We have feared worldly opposition to Your Word, keeping our faith silent in the privacy of our homes. For Jesus' sake forgive us; grant us strength of faith and opportunity to share that faith with boldness, confident of Your forgiveness, protection, and guidance.


