THE DAY OF PENTECOST

May 19, 2024

AS WE GATHER This day was promised by Jesus, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be My witnesses..." (Acts 1:8). This day was fulfilled on that Pentecost, when, confirmation of the Spirit's indwelling took the outward appearance of tongues of fire manifesting above each of the 120 disciples waiting in the upper room, per our Lord's instructions. The tongues of fire hearken back to the cloud of smoke by day and the pillar of fire by night that led the ancient Israelites through their wilderness wanderings and into the Land of Promise. Today, we have learned that the Promised Land is one and the same with the Promised One, Jesus, the Messiah. He leads us not into an occupied country for which we must fight to acquire, but rather to a whole new world, a completely new creation, for which He already fought our age-old enemies of the world, the flesh and the devil - and won a resounding victory with His own death, burial and resurrection. And it is on this One, the Lord Jesus, and on His redemptive work, that the Holy Spirit shines His spotlight. You can always tell where the invisible Spirit of God is today by the audible confession of faith in Jesus Christ. Like the confession of faith you will hear our confirmands make today. Hail, Holy Spirit. Hail, Lord Jesus. Hail Heavenly Father - one God, forevermore!

ATTENTION VISITORS We celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion this morning. This holy meal is intended for Christians who acknowledge their need of God's forgiveness in their lives. The Bible teaches that Christ's body and blood are received with the elements of bread and wine and that Christians need to examine themselves before receiving this holy meal. (1Cor. 10 & 11). This meal further expresses a unity of faith as we gather at one table to receive the assurance of God's forgiveness through the body and blood of our Lord in the sacrament. We welcome baptized Christians to commune with us, those who believe and confess this same faith and understanding of the sacrament and of the Christian life. Persons who desire to receive grape juice select from the darker glasses. If you have any further questions concerning the sacrament, please ask to speak to the Pastor.
