Growing In the Faith...



Green season is green lit...

Southern Californians know this all too well: after a fire, new growth sprouts. We've all seen it: the bright green blades of infant grass popping up against the dark, charcoaled backdrop of the fire's scorched earth. It's like an innocent babe entering a big, cruel world! Does this little sprout have any idea of what it's getting itself into?

"Taking captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Corinthians 10:5), we can take a deeper look at this contrasting scene and make spiritual connections—specifically, with Messianic prophecy. Isaiah 11:1 comes to mind: "A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit." That "Shoot" is Jesus—the Christ. From the time Jesus was born, the jealous anger of evil men (like Herod) burned with hatred against God's Anointed. Such burning "fire" reveals the dark, destructive side of fire.

But in the end, despite the evil in men's hearts, three days after His crucifixion, Jesus arose triumphant over sin, death, and the devil's schemes! Jesus tamed and turned man's worst enemies into tools for God's own purposes. The Christian's grave has been domesticated into the body's dormitory until Heaven's trumpet signals Christ's return and the instantaneous glorification of all those baptized bodies that were "asleep in Christ" (1 Thessalonians 4:14).

Another example comes from our recent celebration of Pentecost Sunday. There, we heard about the "tongues of fire" that rested above the disciples' heads, signifying the Presence of God the Holy Spirit. These flames, far from destroying their "human host," enlivened and empowered them to bear witness to Christ's atoning sacrifice and resurrection victory over death for all sinners. It is that same promised Holy Spirit who is now bestowed in the waters of Holy Baptism; and, just this last Pentecost Sunday, it is the same Holy Spirit Whom we witnessed embolden our two confirmands, Marshall and Blake, to publicly bear witness to their growing faith in Christ. Now, as communing members, their faith will be sustained & strengthened through the Holy Supper, as well as the Word.

The Church now enjoys feeding on the juicy green pastures continually sprouting God's Word during this long, growing "Green Season" of the Church Year. Pentecost's red tongues of fire indicate that the light has turned green for "Go… and Grow." I hope you have a nice Bible study to be a part of this summer and the discipline of attending church every Lord's Day. The Divine Service is where God's sheep find the "meat and potatoes" of green pastures and Holy Sacraments. 
ELDERS CORNER

What good is it . . . if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? — James 2:14


Many of us have heard the old saying "Actions speak louder than words." But this statement is not always true. Sometimes a few careless words spoken in anger or frustration can cause irreparable damage. Like a spark that can set a whole forest on fire, words can be incredibly destructive (James 3:1-12). However, in many cases actions do speak louder than words. This is James's point when he says that faith without deeds is dead. Faith that does not lead to doing good deeds is useless, says James. A fruit tree that does not produce fruit only takes up space in an orchard. It is cut down and burned, and a new tree is planted in its place (Matthew 7:15-20). Paul makes it clear in Ephesians 2:8-10 that we are saved by grace and not by works. Yet James points out that all who are saved by grace will begin to produce good works. That is why in Matthew 7:15-20 Jesus says people can be known by their fruit—revealing whether they are citizens of the eternal kingdom of God or citizens of this world, which is passing away.

This is the time of year where we look for volunteers to use their talents to serve God's kingdom here on earth. We need many volunteers to serve on the various boards and offices. So, if you are asked to join a board or become an officer please prayerfully consider your answer. Better yet, seek out Pastor Mike, an elder, or any board member or officer and let them know you would like to serve. You can also ask Diana Wanke or Irene Hutchison where help is needed and match your talents to open positions.

Help me today, Lord, to examine my life to see if I am producing fruit that shows I am a child of yours. Help me to put off my old sinful nature and to live for your glory alone. In Jesus' name, Amen.




SET SAIL FOR SUMMER CAMP!
